#### 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

President Jim Thompson called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

3. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 15, 2022

Director Lee Peterson motioned to approve the minutes from September 15, 2022, seconded by Director Chancy Cruse. Motion passed unanimously.

4. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON SEPTEMBER 2022 EXPENDITURES

General Manager, Britney Britten stated September was the end of our fiscal year and the District ended under budget. Director Peterson asked for financial information on the new database. Britten explained that the total amount on that line item is reflective of payments made for the new database (Halff), and the final payment made to the old database company (INTERA).

Director John R. Spearman, Jr. motioned to approve the September 20222 expenditures, seconded by Lee Peterson. Motion passed unanimously.

# 11. DISCUSSION ON DISTRICT'S TAX ABATEMENT GUIDELINES

Britten stated when we had our last tax abatement, Director Charles Bowers wanted to look at making changes to our Rainwater Harvesting program. Director David Hodges explained how to calculate the size of tank that's needed per the square footage of a roof. Director Danny Hardcastle said we should be figuring out the best source of re-catchment for businesses with higher square footage due to the fact that the District wouldn't be able to fund half of those larger projects.

Director Charles Bowers motioned for the General Manager to contact HPWD and suggest both Districts follow the Tax Appraisal boundary line for Armstrong County, seconded by Director Danny Hardcastle. Motioned passed unanimously.

# 13. REPORT FROM RULES COMMITTEE AND DISCUSSION ON DISTRICT RULES

Britten stated the Rules Committee met on October 20 to discuss any changes to the District Rules regarding fines. Bowers said the committee looked at different fining structures and ultimately thought the current structure was adequate for now. Britten said we are still early in this process and will still need a few years of data to see what changes would be appropriate, if any at all.

Director Danny Hardcastle motioned to table the discussion for a later date, seconded by Director Lee Peterson. The motion passed unanimously.
